Jody offers immersive painting workshops on the grounds of the Chautauqua Institution and European art excursions. Additionally, she teaches watercolor classes at the Carnegie Art Center.

Erie Canal 200th Anniversary 2025

The Erie Canal runs just North of Albany in Waterford, NY, which is the convergence of the Mohawk and Hudson Rivers, and it spans 363 miles to meet the Niagara River at Tonawanda and North Tonawanda, NY. At the time of its construction, between 1817 and 1825, the Erie Canal was the second-longest in the world.

2025 will mark the 200th anniversary of the Erie Canal's opening and celebrations will be held across the state. Buffalo, NY will have a prominent position as the host of the 2025 World Canals Conference, which attracts canal and inland waterway enthusiasts, professionals, and scholars from around the globe.
